CONSOLIDATION OF THE TEACHERS' PENSIONS REGULATIONS 1997

I am writing further to my previous letters about consolidation of the teachers' pensions regulations and now enclose draft regulations plus commentary on:

- Additional Pension
- Core Definitions

As I explained in my previous letter, issuing draft regulations in batches does mean that cross-references to other regulations cannot be finalised, indicated by the use of square brackets. Perhaps I might also remind that gender-neutral drafting has been used wherever possible in the consolidated regulations. You will also note that, until we are in a position to pull the individual sections together, the draft regulations are numbered numerically 1, 2, 3 etc within each batch.


