Historic contributions factsheet

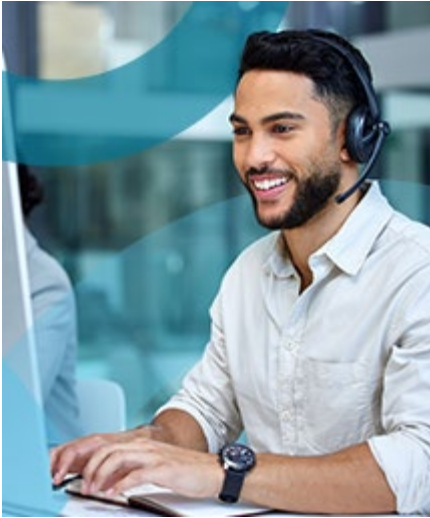
After taking onboard feedback from our focus groups, we've created a factsheet that shows the historic employer and member contribution rates for the Teachers' Pension Scheme.
