

Governance



The Public Service Pensions Act 2013 requires the Secretary of State for Education, as scheme manager of the Teachers' Pension Scheme (TPS), to establish a Pension Board and a Scheme Advisory Board. They are two separate bodies with different responsibilities.

Pension Board The TPS Pension Board (TPSPB) provides assurance of the effectiveness of the administrative arrangements. The TPSPB meets quarterly and information regarding the meetings, as well as further information about the Board can be found [here](#).

Scheme Advisory Board The Scheme Advisory Board (TPSAB) is a forum through which the Secretary of State can request advice from member and employer representatives on the desirability of changes to the scheme rules. It is also a forum for stakeholders to raise questions or concerns about TPS policy issues. The TPSAB meets at least three times a year and information regarding meetings can be found [here](#).
