No, if you're a pension credit member of the Teachers' Pension Scheme you can't transfer in benefits from another pension scheme.

Frequently Asked Question 2: I'm a pension credit member; can I transfer my pension to my own sch

Answer:  
No, if you're a pension credit member of the Teachers' Pension Scheme you can't transfer your benefits out to another pension scheme.

Frequently Asked Question 3: I'm a pension credit member can I purchase additional flexibilities in tl

Answer:  
No, if you're a pension credit member of the Teachers' Pension Scheme you're not eligible to purchase additional flexibilities in the Scheme.

You won't receive a pension until your ex-spouse or partner draws their retirement benefits. If your ex-spouse or partner retires early or leaves the Scheme, the benefits may be less than you originally expected to receive.

No your pension will cease when your ex- spouse dies.

#### Frequently Asked Question 6: I am a pension credit member. If I remarry, will my pension be stoppe

Answer:

No, you'll continue to receive your pension as a pension credit member of the Scheme.

#### Frequently Asked Question 7: I'm receiving a pension as a result of a Pension Attachment Order (earr

Answer:

That depends on the Pension Attachment Order but generally it does mean your pension will be stopped.

#### Frequently Asked Question 8: I am a pension credit member. When I die will anyone be entitled to c

Answer:

As a pension credit member, you can't nominate anyone to continue to receive your Teachers' Pension when you die.

If you were entitled to a Lump Sum payment as part of your pension credit member benefits and you die before or, within five years of taking your benefits, a death grant may be payable. You can nominate someone to receive that death grant.
