We've had an increase of members enquiring about their Teachers' Pensions Reference number (also known as the DfE number). This is the number given to you when you qualify as a teacher in the UK. It's important that you keep a note of it. But don't worry if you've misplaced it, here's how you can find it:

- Ask your employer they'll hold a record of your individual DfE number
- Check any previous correspondence we'll have used this number in any previous communications
- Call us on 0345 606 6166 and verify your identity
- If you work in Wales, please contact the Education Workforce Council on 0292 046 0099.
- If you work for a High Education or Further Education establishment please contact your employer initially who can provide your number.
