MCR MAT on-boarding

If you've any new establishments joining your Multi Academy Trust (MAT), they'll need to submit a Monthly Contributions Reconciliation (MCR) <u>On-boarding form</u>. New establishments won't automatically join MCR, even if the MAT has already on-boarded.

They'll also need to submit a <u>Delegation form</u> to ensure the appropriate people have access to the <u>Employer Portal</u>.
