- Under the provisions of the Public Service Pensions and Judicial Office Act 2022 a person who has pensionable public service in another scheme is eligible for the transitional protection remedy regardless of whether they transfer in to the Teachers' Pension Scheme or not.
- In some schemes protection was afforded to members who were in eligible employment on 31 March 2012 as well as the scheme closing date, or did not have a relevant break exceeding five years, spanning these dates.
- The information provided on this form will assist Teachers' Pensions in identifying whether a person is subject to the remedy, even where a member has transferred from a previous public service scheme.
- Members covered for protection under the Transitional Protection remedy may be entitled to a final salary link. A member who transfers in from another public service scheme will be entitled to have previous final salary service linked to their of the Public Service 7 current earnings in the Teachers' Pensions career average scheme. This is on account of Schedule 2013 Pensions Act.

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
