We've identified some Payroll Providers and Multi Academy Trusts (MATs) are sending in their service submissions with incorrect school numbers.

MATs and Payroll Providers can now be set up with their own reference number and can submit the schools they manage under one data centre, as opposed to submitting each file under the schools' reference. However, it's important that a member's service is always recorded under the school they work at. If you want to provide all data under one submission (data centre) then you'll need to apply for MAT or Payroll Provider access.
